**Resolution No. 1/32-ORG**  
**On**  
**Requests for OIC Observer Status or Full Membership**

*The Thirty-second Session of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers (Session of Integration and Development), held in Sana'a, Republic of Yemen, from 21-23 Jumada Al-Awwal 1426H (28-30 June, 2005),*

**Recalling** the principles and objectives of the OIC Charter;

**Recalling** also the relevant Resolutions adopted by Islamic Summits and Foreign Ministers Conferences, latest of which Resolution No. 2/7-ORG (IS) on the regulation governing Observer status of the Organization of the Islamic Conference adopted by the Seventh Islamic Summit Conference, and also Resolutions No. 1/25-ORG and No. 67/27-P on the procedures for full membership at the OIC, adopted by the 25<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> Islamic Conferences of Foreign Ministers;

**Having taken cognizance** of the Report of the Secretary-General of the Organization of the Islamic Conference contained in Document No. OIC/ICFM-32/2005/ORG/SG.REP.1;

**Convinced** that promotion of Islamic causes and creation of greater harmony and understanding between the OIC and non member states and international and regional organizations is an aspired goal, and that establishing a global partnership for dialogue may be given consideration by OIC;

**Having taken cognizance** of the growing number of applications for observer status or full membership of the Organization of the Islamic Conference,

- 1- **Decides** to refer the report of the Intergovernmental Group of Experts on Review of the Rules of Observer Status at the OIC back to the said Group for reconsideration.
- 2- **Requests** the Secretary-General to follow up the implementation of this Resolution and submit a report thereon to the thirty-third session of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers.

**Resolution No. 2/32-ORG**  
**On**  
**Candidacies presented by**  
**Member States For Posts in International Organizations**

*The Thirty-second Session of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers (Session of Integration and Development), held in Sana'a, Republic of Yemen, from 21-23 Jumada Al-Awwal 1426H (28-30 June, 2005),*

**Aware** of the importance of representation of Islamic States in various international positions;

**Having considered** the candidacies presented by Member States in this regard;

**Decides** to support the following candidacies:

- 1- **Candidacy of the State of Qatar** for non-permanent membership in the UN Security Council for 2006/2007 at the elections to be held on the sidelines of the Sixtieth Session of the United Nations General Assembly, in 2005.
- 2- **Candidacy of the State of Qatar** for membership in the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations at the elections to be held during the resumed organizational session of the Economic and Social Council, in April 2006.
- 3- **Candidacy of the State of Qatar** for membership in the Executive Council of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) at the elections to be held during the 33<sup>rd</sup> UNESCO General Conference, in October 2005.
- 4- **Candidacy of Ambassador Boualam Bouqataya (Peoples' Democratic Republic of Algeria)** to the position of judge at the International Court on the Law of the Sea, during the election to be held in June 2005.
- 5- **Candidacy of the Republic of Tunisia** for membership of the Executive Council of the International Labour Organization as an alternate member for the period 2005 – 2008.
- 6- **Candidacy of Dr Abdelfattah Omar (Republic of Tunisia)** to the position of judge at the International Court of Justice.

- 7- **Candidature of the Islamic Republic of Iran for the membership of the Executive Board of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)**, for which elections are to be held during the 33<sup>rd</sup> UNESCO General Assembly in October 2005.
8. **Candidature of the Islamic Republic of Iran for membership at Group (C) of the Executive Council of the International Maritime Organization (IMO)** at the elections to be held during the 24<sup>th</sup> IMO Assembly in December 2005 in London.
9. **Re-election of Professor Djamshid Momtaz (Islamic Republic of Iran) to the International Law Commission** at the elections to be held during the 61<sup>st</sup> Session of the United Nations General Assembly in September 2006 in New York.
10. **Candidature of the Republic of Tunisia for the chairmanship of the Executive Council of the World Tourism Organization** for 2006, during the elections to be held in Dakar in December 2005.
11. **Candidature of the Republic of Tunisia for membership of the World Heritage Commission of UNESCO** during the 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the General Assembly of Member States in the Commission at the 33<sup>rd</sup> General Conference of UNESCO, scheduled for Paris in October 2005.

**Resolution No. 3/32-ORG**  
**On**  
**Support of the Secretary General's OIC Reform Plan**

*The Thirty-second Session of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers  
(Session of Integration and Development held in Sana'a, Republic of Yemen, from  
21-23 Jumada Al-Awwal 1426H (28-30 June, 2005),*

**Recalling** the principles and objectives of the Charter;

**Affirming** the need for the Organization of the Islamic Conference to assume a more effective and dynamic role to achieve the objectives for which it was founded, and to promote solidarity and cooperation between OIC Member States;

**Taking note** with appreciation of the work of the OIC Commission on Eminent Persons and the report of Accenture on *The re-structuring of the General Secretariat*;

**Taking into account** the statements by the Ministers of Foreign Affairs of OIC Member States and the Secretary General on the review and development of work mechanisms in the Organization of the Islamic Conference in an effort to achieve efficiency, rationalize work in the OIC, reorganize its administrations, and improve the level of its performance:

1. **Decides** to reinvigorate the open-ended intergovernmental group of experts established by the 8<sup>th</sup> Islamic Summit and reaffirmed by the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Summits of the OIC to review the Organization's Charter and Statutes and the General Secretariat's Rules of procedure and the various committees and, if necessary, to form specialized ad-hoc groups.
2. **Requests** the Secretary General to follow up on the implementation of this resolution and to report thereon to the 33rd Session of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers.
