Working paper on implementation of the Recommendations of the Ministerial  
Committee of the First Islamic Conference of Youth and Sports Ministers**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Islamic Conference of Youth and Sports Ministers, held in Jeddah, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, on 16-17 Jumada I 1435 A.H., corresponding to 17-18 March 2014, under the patronage of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz Al Saud (may Allah preserve him),

- Having considered the working paper on implementation of the recommendations of the Ministerial Committee of the First Islamic Conference of Youth and Sports Ministers on youth supervision and coordination office in Member States,
- Pursuant to discussions,

**Decides the following:**

1. **To adopt** the working paper on implementation of the recommendations of the Ministerial Committee of the First Islamic Conference of Youth and Sports Ministers on Youth Supervision and Coordination Office in Member States.
2. **To Convey** gratitude to the Government of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and to the president of the Islamic Solidarity Sports Federation for the efforts and executive measures made to establish and support the office with human competencies and expertise to manage and implement its programmes.
3. **To amend** the name of the Youth supervision and coordination office in Member States to "Youth Council in Islamic Countries" within the framework of the Islamic Solidarity Sports Federation, to be based in Riyadh; and that Prince Nawaf Ibn Faisal Ibn Fahd President General of Youth Welfare in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and president of the Islamic Solidarity Sports Federation should continue as president of the Council.
4. **To constitute** a consultative committee under the chairmanship of chairman of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Islamic Conference of Youth and Sports Ministers and membership of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation, the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural organization, and the Islamic solidarity Sports Federation, Islamic Conference Youth Forum for Dialogue and Cooperation, and six experts representing the Arab Group, the Asian Group and the African Group selected on the basis of states' nominations to review the objectives and procedural functions in light of the change of the Council's name, to propose organizational structure and management and technical units for the Council, and to mandate the Conference Chair to adopt the Committee's recommendations.

- - Having considered the Draft Executive Plan for the Initiative of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques for Dialogue among the Followers of Religions and Cultures: Achievements and Future Prospects, and

**Decides the following:**

- 1. Adopts** the Draft “Executive Plan for the Initiative of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques for interreligious and intercultural dialogue, taking into account the observations of the Conference members.
- 2. Reiterates** thanks and gratitude to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques for launching this historic initiative and pioneering civilizational project aimed at fostering the values of peace, security, harmony and tolerance, and to highlight the contribution of Islam and Muslims in this regard to the best interest of humanity at large.
